SAC Election Results – Rich Thomas

- Dixon Cravens appointed new voting member for SAC 2010/2011. 180 people voted online this year, which was excellent.

Update on UIP/SIP and Budget – Steve Johnson

- Mandate approach to improvement process for struggling schools.
- Vista is on a performance plan – all is good!
 - Academic achievement has exceeded state standards @ 87.5%
 - Academic growth is at 75% - we need to focus on this area
 - Academic growth gaps are at 61.7%
 - Post-secondary and workforce readiness – 100%
 - Weighted total – 83.7%
- UIP is not yet available
- In the future, student growth will encompass a higher percentage of teacher success, as well as how they are compensated financially.
- Vista is rolling over \$80,000 from last year – will go back to the departments
- Current enrollment is 2060 students. Class sizes have increased.
